



Siding

Permit requirements

- Submit a completed building permit application to the City of Mendota Heights, available at the City's website www.mendota-heights.com or the City Hall.
- Separate permits are required for electrical work.

Permit fees

- Building permit fees are based on the submitted valuation (1300.0160 Subp. 4).
- The permit fee is 1% of valuation with a minimum of \$100.00.

Building requirements

- Install siding in accordance with the manufacturer's installation guidelines.
- One layer of No. 15 asphalt felt, free from holes and breaks, complying with ASTM D 226 for Type 1 felt or other approved water-resistive barrier shall be applied over studs or sheathing of all exterior walls (R703.2).
- Approved corrosion-resistant flashing shall be applied shingle-fashion in such a manner as to prevent entry of water into the wall cavity or penetration of water to the building structural framing components (R703.8).

Electrical requirements

- An electrical permit is required when electrical equipment is removed and reinstalled.
- Electrical equipment can be removed by the siding installer, however a licensed electrical contractor must obtain a permit and perform the reinstallation of all electrical equipment.
