BUSINESS RECYCLING INCENTIVE FUNDING

Dakota County provides up to **\$10,000** per business or organization location to reduce waste, design a new or improved recycling program or start organics recycling. No funding match is required.

Who is eligible?

Businesses, organizations and multi-unit dwellings located in Dakota County that are subject to the state recycling requirement.

Items covered

- Recycling containers and bins
- Recycling equipment purchases
- Improvements to loading docks and waste enclosures
- Educational materials and employee training
- Compostable products (up to six months)
- Organics hauling service charges (up to six months)
- Reusable service ware
- And more
